About the Cadet Program

Our cadet opportunities are in Financial Audit and Performance Audit. In each program you will have the opportunity to rotate through other business units within the Office, and/or other government departments.

Financial Audit

A financial audit provides assurance that the financial statements of an entity present fairly the financial position, cash flows and results of operations for the year, in accordance with relevant financial reporting frameworks and standards.

Performance Audit

A performance audit assesses whether an agency is meeting its aims effectively, using its resources economically and efficiently, and complying with legislation. Performance audits extend beyond the examination of the financial affairs and transactions of a government agency to encompass wider management issues of significance to the community.

Who can apply?

The cadet program is open to individuals who have recently commenced (but not completed) University studies and wish to pursue a career in accounting or auditing.
